Why do blisters appear?

There are various types of blisters such as:

- Friction blisters
- Heat blisters
- Blood blisters
- Blisters caused by diseases or allergic conditions

Coverplast Blisters is indicated to be used on blisters typically caused by friction from wearing ill-fitting or stiff shoes.

There are four stages in the blister formation:



Stage 1 Feeling a burning sensation on the skin.



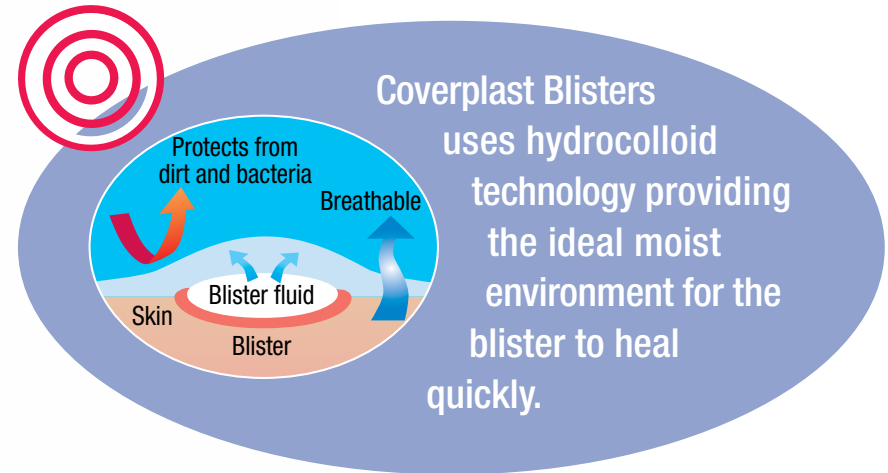
Stage 2 A blister forms – due to the friction in the affected area, fluid starts to collect under the outer layer of the skin cushioning the tissue underneath.



Stage 3 When the blister breaks open – the skin flakes off and the wound might bleed.



Stage 4 A scab forms – as the wound fluid dries up, the nerve endings are left exposed creating long lasting discomfort.



How does Coverplast Blisters work?
